

Depart on a full day historical tour through the 'Rocks' area of Sydney to Parramatta, where visits will be made to Old Government House (1799) Experimental Farm Cottage (1793) and Elizabeth Farm Cottage (1792). Continue to Rouse Hill where lunch will be served colonial style at the Half Way House. After lunch visit Windsor before returning to the ship.

Day 14, 15, 16 At sea.

Arrive **PORT MORESBY.** Depart on 3-hour coach tour to **Tupesilea Village** passing through typical coastal scenery and vegetation. Opportunity to see and photograph the people with a background of typical coastal village built over water. Return is via Koki market.

Day 18 Depart PORT MORESBY.

Day 19, 20, 21, 22 At sea.

Arrive BALI, Leave Benoa harbour for Tjamenggoan to see the worldfamous Ketchak dance, performed in the village temple. After attending the dance, tour will be continued to Tampaksiring via Mas and Ubud, famous for their wood carving and modern painting museum respectively, opportunity for shopping. Arrive at Tampaksiring, where the sacred spring of Tirta Empul is situated. Luncheon will be served at Restaurant Tampaksiring. Return to Benoa to rejoin the ship. Depart BALI in the evening.

Day 24

Arrive **SURABAYA.** Leave Tanjung Perak harbour for **Tretes**, a mountain resort with its lovely panoramic view and good weather, situated about 65 km from the port. Luncheon will be arranged at Tanjung Hotel restaurant. The rest of the time is available for swimming. Return to Tanjung Perak to rejoin the

Depart SURABAYA.

Day 26 At sea.

Arrive JAKARTA. After breakfast on board the ship, leave Tanjung Priok for **Punchak**, a lovely mountain resort situated about 1,200 m above sea level. A brief stop will be made at Tjibinong tropical fruits market and visiting Botanical Gardens in **Bogor**. From Bogor drive up to Punchak, passing through tea plantations. Luncheon will be served at Punchak Pass Restaurant (Rijsttafel). Return to Tanjung Priok to rejoin the ship.

Depart JAKARTA.

Day 29 At sea.

Arrive SINGAPORE. City tour travelling along the waterfront passing the Esplanade, City Hall and Parliament House. Stop at the Singapore River to see typical Chinese Junks and Tongkangs and proceed to the Hindu Temple, Tiger Balm Gardens and the Jade House where exquisite jade collection can be seen.

Day 31 Depart SINGAPORE.

Arrive PENANG. Afternoon drive to Penang Hill station and ascend the Peak by funicular railway, passing through jungle scenery to the top (2,270 ft) for a panoramic view of Georgetown and the mainland. Descend and proceed to the Buddhist temple, Kek Lok Si, still used as a monastery and the first temple in Malaysia, before returning to the ship.

Day 33 Depart PENANG.

Arrive BELAWAN. Leave Belawan for Brastagi by way of Medan city. A refreshment stop is made at Bandar Baru. Continue the drive to Brastagi, where luncheon will be served at Masa Rest House (Rijsttafel and European food). Before returning to Belawan to rejoin the ship, one and a half hour time is available for recreation at Brastagi (horse riding, walking, etc. ...).



By motor coach as specified, including entrance fees where applicable.


HOTEL ACCOMMODATION (in Jogjakarta)
Based on sharing a twinbedded room with private facilities at the Hotel Ambarrukmo or similar.
Passengers travelling alone are obliged to occupy a single room at the supplement shown.

MEALS

All meals included throughout the tour.

SERVICES CHARGES, TAXES

Service charges as imposed by Hotel and restaurants and government taxes are included on all services rendered as per the itinerary. Gratuities to ship's stewards *not* included.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HOW TO BOOK: First decide on the type of accommodation preferred in 'Nieuw Holland'. Then ask your travel agent to contact Lissone Lindeman for a booking. You will be given an offer of accommodation of the type required or the nearest alternative available. A deposit of \$100 per person should be lodged within 10 days of receiving this offer in order to make the booking firm. EARLY APPLICATION IS ADVISED.

BALANCE OF FARES: Payable SIX WEEKS before departure. Tickets and vouchers normally available within 3 weeks of fares being paid, subject to travel documents being in order.

CANCELLATIONS: For cancellations more than 8 weeks prior to departure, a service charge of \$10 per person will be charged. For cancellations less than 8 weeks before departure, cancellation fee of \$50 per person will be charged. However, Royal Interocean Lines reserve the right to retain all or part of the passage fare paid for

cancellations received within 6 weeks of sailing date.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: You will require a valid passport and visa for Indonesia (double entry) together with an International Certificate of Vaccination against smallpox and cholera. Exemption certificates *not* acceptable by Royal Interocean Lines.

INSURANCE: We recommend that you take out Personal Accident and Baggage Insurance for the full period of your tour. Your travel agent will be pleased to arrange this on your behalf.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be made for any sightseeing excursions not taken or for any hotel accommodation or meals not utilised.

FARES: The fares are based on tariffs and exchange rates current at the time of publication and may be subject to increase prior to date of travel.
