Return and roundtrip reductions	A reduction of 10% on the sum of the one way first and tourist class fares can be granted provided the voyage commences and terminates in the same area. Such tickets are valid for 12 months as from the date of embarkation on the ship by which the initial voyage is to be made until the date of embarkation for the return trip.

Deck chairs	A number of deck chairs is on board for passenger's free use. Those who wish to bring their own chair on board may do so free of charge, but at their own risk.


